Updates & Helpful Information: Citrus County

1. **TIRE POLICY: American Racer AR153** - Each Super Late Model team will be limited to a maximum two sets of (new) sticker tires for the weekend (Friday – Saturday).

Trailers will be checked for any new tires onboard. Scuffs may also be inspected and removed by officials if deemed necessary.

Tire pick order is based on the order race entries were received at 3:00pm. Race tires will be picked first, after all teams have picked their race set, then practice tires can be picked. Only one person per car will be allowed in the barn. If you're not present when your name is called, you will be skipped. Tire representative must put race tires in the container Friday night by 9:00pm!

2. **PIT PASS PRICING:**

Friday- Practice/Tech:

- Two Day Pass (Friday and Saturday): \$50
- Friday Only Pit Pass: \$20

Saturday Race Day:

- Saturday Only Pit Pass: \$30

3. **FUEL:** SUNOCO 110 is the spec fuel for the event and must be pure Sunoco 110.
4. **PRE-TECH:** All cars at the track on Friday will undergo inspection by assigned appointments, maximum four crew members, plus the driver with the car in tech inspection. Please stay back away from the car during inspection to allow officials room to conduct inspection. This is a convenience for the teams. Please be on time or the system doesn't work and a penalty may be issued.
5. **SPOTTERS:** Spotters must be utilized at all times your car is on track. The spotter must monitor race control with a scanner or stand-alone radio at 461.2000. Spotter's location will be in designated area marked off in back stretch grandstands.
6. **ON THE GROUND:** Once pre-qualifying tech opens on Saturday, all cars are to be on the ground ready to roll to tech at 4:45pm sharp – hood on, cars on the ground. The penalty will be the slowest of your two qualifying laps if your car is not on the ground at 4:45pm on Saturday. You have been warned – it's in your hands, the rules and policies are for everyone to follow.
7. **REQUIRED DECALS:** The SRL National windshield decal is mandatory. Decals will be handed out at the track on Friday. Windshield decal to be in place prior to car going on track Saturday.
8. **PRIZE MONEY / W9 FORMS:** All teams are required to fill out a Citrus County Speedway 2022 SEASON REGISTRATION FORM, please fill out ahead of time; click this link:
